Pinhole Photography

with Chuck Flagg

Fee \$135

Learn the art of Pin Hole photography! In this class students will learn about pinhole photography, construction of a camera, loading, shooting & developing photos. In addition, students will also do some contact printing.

All photo paper, chemicals and developing equipment will be supplied. Also construction materials for camera supplied. Student should bring an empty black 35mm film canister or a small Pringles potato chip can.

Fine Metal Clay & Jewelry Making Techniques

with Lise' Mundwiller

Discover the wonder of turning a lump of clay into pure silver with your very own design elements!

In this workshop you will learn the history, composition, and methods of transforming metal clay into pure silver.

You will shape, carve, or mold your piece into a design, then dry, fire and polish your finished piece.

A brief description and demonstration of the new bronze clay will also be featured.

In addition you will also learn the basic jewelry techniques of wire wrapping and bead stringing. You may bring your own stones or beads to string, or kits will be available for purchase. Art clay may be purchased from the teacher.

Equipment needed: Round nose and Chain nose jewelry pliers, Art Clay 20gm, Teflon Non-stick sheet, roller.

Optional items: jewelry files, fine grit sandpaper, emery nail files, and wire cutters. Instructor will bring additional equipment that may be used in class.

Sewing and a Little More

Students will create two projects during the weekend, a Casserole Tote & a Simple Apron. There will be an embroidery machine available during class for students to add an embellishment.

Students will need to bring fabric and materials for each project. A list of needed materials will be mailed to students prior to the class.

Lace Knitting

Knitted lace adds elegance and interest to any project. This class will focus on the basics of lace knitting, key stitch combinations and hints for making perfect lace even for less experienced knitters. Students will begin a lace sampler that can be carried on after the class to create the perfect place to try out new lace patterns. Subjects will include choosing a lace pattern to fit a project, styles of lace and how to block a finished project. Students may want to bring a variety of needle sizes to experiment with different yarns. Materials fee of \$10.00 includes 1 set of needles and a variety of yarns and threads.

Classes will be held August 19-21 in the Three Sisters Park pavilion in Chillicothe, IL. Classes begin Friday, August 19, with an evening Meet 'N' Greet in the Park pavilion. Check in is 6:30-7:00 p.m. at the registration desk. Instructors will present a brief class overview from 7-9:00 p.m. Classes continue Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. A public open house to view student work will be held in the pavilion from 2-3:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon.

An 8:30 a.m. continental breakfast will be provided to students and instructors on

Saturday and Sunday and lunch will be served at noon. These meals are included in your registration fee. Lunch menus will be posted online at ThreeSistersFolkArtSchool.com a week before the event.

Students must be at least 18 years of age or have prior permission to attend from class instructors. The Park pavilion has accessible entrances and restrooms. Please contact the staff at Three Sisters Folk Art School if you have specific accessibility questions or concerns.

Classes run concurrently, so please register for one class only. Class fees are due at

registration. Class sizes are limited—register early to secure your spot! Classes may be cancelled if minimum enrollment is not met.

Registrations are non-transferable and nonrefundable unless approved by the Folk Art School board. If a class is cancelled, a second choice class will be offered if available, or registration fees will be refunded. Some classes may require specific tools and materials. Material and kit fees should be paid to the instructor on Friday evening.
